This investment group's objective is to generate an appropriate return in Swiss francs by taking advantage of the possibilities for international diversification. It invests worldwide in fixed and variable-rate securities, equities, and indirect real estate investments. Equity investments comprise between 20% and 30% of the net assets. The unhedged portion of investments with foreign currency exposure may not exceed 20% of the net assets.
